# 日本北陆+长野冬之旅

## 第一天 吉隆坡 / 大阪

机上用餐

集合于吉隆坡国际机场，乘搭班机前往大阪关西国际机场。抵达后，由导游送往入住酒店。

住宿：关西N门酒店或同级（当地4星级酒店）

## 第二天 大阪 / 京都 / 岐阜

早 / 午 / 晚

早餐后，首先我们将游览大阪著名的大阪城。游毕后，将前往京都游览伏见稻荷大社。日本约有1/3的神社属于稻荷神社，我们将游览的，是稻荷神社的总本社，地位崇高、历史悠久。入口处矗立着由丰臣秀吉于1589年捐赠的大鸟居，后面是神社的主殿及其他建筑物，尤以“千本鸟居”最为著名。过后，将游览世界文化遗产清水寺，是一座位于京都的寺院。寺院建筑气势宏伟，结构巧妙，木筑成的木台为日本所罕有。位于清水寺外面的三年坂二年坂是极具京都风情的坡道，也是日本重要传统的建造物群保护地区。二年坂从北面的高台寺往南延伸至三年坂，一路连绵着保留了红壳格子和虫笼窗式的古老町家建筑，极具韵味。毕后，前往岐阜入住酒店。

## 第三天 岐阜 / 白川乡 / 金泽

早 / 午 / 晚

早餐后，乘车前往郡上八幡，参观独特的塑料食物样本。郡上八幡位于岐阜县中央的奥美浓的中心，长良川上游与支流吉田川会合之处，是16世纪修建的郡上八幡城的“城下町”（以诸侯的居城为中心发展起来的城镇）。毕后，前往飞弹高山老街，是400年前高山城主金森长近仿效京都开发的城下町（城堡周围的城市）。金森长近是丰田秀吉麾下的历史名将，在飞驒地区留下城郭、神社与佛堂等许多历史遗迹。金森长近曾在干利休及古田织部等茶道名师之下学习，据说高山如此优美的街景就是受到茶道深奥的境界所带来的独特美感的影響。过后，前往1995年被联合国教科文组织列为世界文化遗产的白川乡合掌村（含门票），参观日本传统建筑珍宝，百多栋【合掌造】茅草屋顶的民家，造型非常特殊，营造出一种很幻想式的田野风情。

住宿：MYSTAYS 金泽精品酒店或同级（当地4星级酒店）

## 第四天 金泽 / 长野 / 松本

早 / 晚

早餐后，前往长野游览雪猴公园，是一群非常特别的猴子的家。该公园创建于1964年，是作为一个保护区而建立的。一旦进入公园，这些天生好奇的猴子观察到人类使用附近宾馆的温泉，不久就开始模仿这种行为。毕后，前往鹿岛枪滑雪场，是一览高鹿岛枪岳（2890米）盛景的稀缺滑雪场。山脚下的“PLAZA 830”和半山腰上的“Central Plaza 1130”全天向游客提供各类服务，两个游客广场为中心辐射出22条个性化设计的滑道，有适合儿童和初学者的初级滑道，也有专门为高级游客设计的高难度滑道。（不含滑雪工具 JPY10000）

住宿：安曇野泉乡酒店或同级（当地4星级酒店）

## 第五天 松本 / 富士山

早 / 午 / 晚

早餐后，前往日本最大的名牌折扣店-奥特莱斯购物城，拥有欧风式的建筑外观，这里就聚集了许多日本国内外著名品牌专营店。毕后，我们将乘车前往富士山，是日本一座横跨静冈县和山梨县的活火山，富士山顶于冬季积雪，直至隔年六、七月才会溶化，高度为3775米，是日本国内的最高峰。尔后，驱车前往游览忍野八海村，富士山雪水流经地层过滤成清澈的淡水，再从忍野八个地方涌出来，平均水温约摄氏十三度，水质清冽甘甜，1985年入选“日本名水百选”。

住宿：富士山花园温泉酒店（当地4星级酒店）

## 第六天 富士山 / 东京 / 吉隆坡

今早餐后，前往东京参观最古老的寺庙浅草观音寺。又名金龍山浅草寺，是东京都内历史最悠久的寺院。这座寺庙的标志是在门前悬挂着巨大红的灯笼。引向寺庙的仲见世商店街，街道两旁摆满了各种传统日本小吃摊位，您还可以在这里买到精致漂亮的纪念品。之后，途经著名的东京晴空塔和国会大厦。继续前往全世界地价最贵的银座，能在银座消费是一种高级身份象征。游毕后，将前往东京人气打卡地-御台场，这里集合了时尚餐饮娱乐于一身，这里的海滨公园，彩虹大桥，大型商城以及娱乐设施，都可让您尽情观光。毕后，送往机场乘搭客机飞返美丽的家园。

### Day 1 KUALA LUMPUR / OSAKA

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your departure flight to Osaka. Upon arrival, check in hotel.

### Day 2 OSAKA / KYOTO / GIFU

B / L / D

After breakfast, proceed to view **Osaka Castle**. The construction of Osaka Castle, started in 1583 on the former site of the Ishiyama Honganji Temple, which had been destroyed by Oda Nobunaga thirteen years earlier. Toyotomi Hideyoshi intended the castle to become the center of a new, unified Japan under Toyotomi rule. It was the largest castle at the time. After this proceed to Kyoto for visit **Fushimi Inari taisha**, is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice. After that proceed to **Kiyomizu Temple** is a pillar-structured temple. The building of the monastery is magnificent and ingenious in structure, without using a single nail. The wooden platform made of six layers of torch wood in the temple is rare in Japan. Then will walking at **Ninenzaka** and **Sannenzaka** are Japanese traditional streets located in the historical district of Higashiyama in eastern Kyoto. The cobbled pedestrian alleys connect the neighborhoods' temples, and restaurants and souvenir shops line along their large stone stairways.

### Day 3 GIFU / TAKAYAMA / SHIRAKAWAGO / KANAZAWA

After breakfast, proceed to visit **Gujo Hachiman**, the Food Replica Shop, few people know that the plastic "food sample", seen outside virtually every restaurant in Japan was invented in Gujo Hachiman. Visitors to Gujo Hachiman have a unique opportunity to visit where food samples for approximately 80% of restaurants in Japan are made. After that visit to **Takayama's old town**, has been beautifully preserved with many buildings and whole streets of houses dating from the Edo Period (1600-1868), when the city thrived as a wealthy town of merchants. Then will proceed to **Shirakawago Gassho Village**, nestled in a rural setting reminiscent of the old Japan, Shinkawago is world famous for its steeply thatched roofed or 'gassho-zukuri' style traditional of the finest in craftsmanship.

### Day 4 KANAZAWA / NAGANO / MATSUMOTO

After breakfast, visit to **Snow Monkey Park**, is home to a very special troop of monkeys. Created in 1964, the park was established as a conservation area in which the monkeys, Japanese macaques to be exact, would have a refuge within what was already their natural habitat. Once in the park, the naturally-curious monkeys observed humans using the hot spring of a nearby guesthouse and before long, started copying the behaviour. After that, proceed to visit **Kashimayari Resort** is the second southern most resort on the Hakuba Valley Lift Ticket and is an excellent choice for avoiding the crowds at larger resorts such as Happono. The resort has a distinctly Japanese feel and caters primarily to the Japanese ski community.

### Day 5 MATSUMOTO / MT FUJI

After breakfast, proceed to **Outlet** for shopping. After that, visit to **Mt. Fuji**, the most sacred mountain in Japan. The world famous symbol of Japan. Then proceed to **Oshino Hakkai Village** for visit, the eight ponds are fed by snow melt from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji that filters down the mountain through porous layers of lava for over 80 years, resulting in very clear spring water that is revered by the locals.

### Day 6 MT FUJI / TOKYO / KUALA LUMPUR

This morning we will visit the popular **Asakusa Kannon Temple**, the oldest temple in Tokyo which is also famous for its huge red lantern on the Kaminarimon. Not to be missed is definitely a walk along **Nakamise Shopping Street** where one will find a jam-packed selection of souvenirs and traditional Japanese snacks. Next, we will go through for view of Tokyo Sky Tree and Japan Parlimen. After this proceed to **Ginza**, world's most expensive shopping land, with lots of branded shopping places. Then will visit to **Odaiba**, the park has the famous replica of the statue of liberty and is loved by many Japanese. You can enjoy the view of the statute of liberty, ocean, the Rainbow Bridge all together is breathtaking. After this proceed to International Airport for check in to back to Kuala Lumpur.
